# **KINDERGARTEN CARE (KCARE)**

**KCare** is provided to parents who require a full-day service for their child. KCare provides care services, and **time** and **space** for children to **play**, **explore** and **discover** through **specially designed environments with carefully chosen resources**.

**KCare** aims to provide opportunities for children to develop confidence in

communicating with others, social skills,

self-help skills and values such as responsibility, care and respect.

# **KCARE FEE – SUBSIDIES TIER**

#### Subsidies are provided by MOE in 2 tiers:

- Basic Subsidy: All SC children are eligible for and automatically given a Basic Subsidy of \$150 per month.
- Additional Subsidy (applicable only if KiFAS application is successful): Tiered according to income for SC children provided they meet the following criteria:
  - a) The mother/single father of the SC child is working at least 56 hours a month; and
  - b) The family's total monthly HHI is no higher than \$12,000 or the PCI is no higher than \$3,000. Note that MOE will take reference from the approved ECDA KIFAS for this assessment.

Note: The child must attend at least 1 day of KCare to qualify for the monthly subsidies.
