### SCHOOL-BASED ASSESSMENT PLAN FOR 2023 – PRIMARY 6

Do note that our P6 students will **not** be sitting for the Mid-Year Examination (MYE). Instead, we will be conducting Weighted Assessments (WA) such as class tests, projects and presentations termly in Term 1 and Term 2. There will be no more than one WA per subject per term. The Preliminary Examination will be held in Term 3.

In Angsana Primary School, we are committed to **nurturing the whole child and focussing on 'learning for life'**. Our teachers will focus on deepening learning in the classrooms, nurturing in our students stronger intrinsic motivation to learn, as well as helping our students to develop dispositions for lifelong learning.

Even with the removal of MYE, information about the students' understanding, learning progress and content mastery will continue to be gathered to improve students' learning and teachers' instructions through **check-points** such as daily in-class work and discussions, reviewing of students' homework, bite-size tests, and observations of and interactions with students.

Our teachers will deploy a **variety of assessment modes** that are fit-for-purpose and will provide students with timely feedback to address learning gaps. We will help our students to focus on learning for mastery, and not overly rely on grades and marks to measure their learning progress. Please refer to [Annex A](#) for the outline of the coverage of the WA and Preliminary Examination for this year.

It is important that you encourage your child/ward to **focus on learning** and not whether the assessment is counted towards the overall subject results or not. Please be our partner in affirming your child's/ward's efforts and progress made, as well as in inculcating in your child/ward good study habits such as completing assignments in a timely manner.

#### Absence During School-Based Assessment

For the well-being of your child/ward and in the interest of all our students, we encourage you to exercise social responsibility by keeping your child/ward at home if he/she is unwell. Students who are unwell should seek medical attention and obtain a valid medical certificate from a certified medical practitioner to be excused from the assessment.

With the exception of the oral examination, there will be **no make-up session(s)** for any component or paper which students have missed during the Weighted Assessments (WA) and Preliminary Examination. Marks will be pro-rated for students who miss any component or paper provided they have a valid medical certificate.
